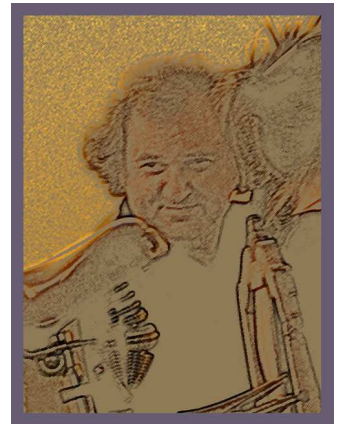


MELODIOUS MUSEUM - MUSIC MEETS FINE ARTS



At the Kirsten Kjær's Museum – on Sunday, August 28th, 2011 ; between 10:00-17:00

KKM is a rare place of arts in the broadest sense, be it painting, sculpting, graphic work and last but not least – music! The significance of music has deepened since the concert hall has been built – thus turning it into a modest temple of music. At the same time the concerts became more complex, attracting the attention of yet more musicians and a broader audience. Meanwhile it is almost impossible to fit all the requests into the event-calendar. Exhibitions, workshops, artists and composer in residence, music festivals, symposiums – all these are turning this place into a true Mecca of culture, experiments and openness. And it would even deepen the spirit of the place if the different arts would meet and cross-fertilise in an active way more often.

Therefore, the idea evolved, to start a periodic day of open house presentation with the exhibiting fine artists and musicians from various backgrounds, especially those who already know and appreciate the place, and are eager to help to maintain its copiousness. There will be several short melodious guided tour through the new galleries of the museum, creating the opportunity of an immediate exchange between musicians, artists and visitors/audience. In between those there will be small sessions in the concert hall, where the audience can propose themes to which the musicians will try to find a musical answer and language.

The musicians are: Bernadette Zeilinger (A; recorder), Lorenz Schuster (D; electronics), Erik Sandberg (S; horn), Marius Ungureanu (RO; viola and voice). Visitors and audience are welcome to bring their own instrument to join in a final impro-session in the Concert Hall.
